### Overview:

- Instagram contest inviting the local community to submit art or photographs that 'embodies community'
- Winning entry receives \$500 and promotion through PIN website, social media and through PIN's 'Time to Give' National Volunteer Week celebrations
- Winning entry is developed into a small framed print for PIN's Volunteer Awards in five categories for 2022.

### Details and Timeline:

- Entries welcomed between February 1 – 15<sup>th</sup>
- Entries submitted via Instagram:
  - Tag @PINnetworkGW and use #PINHereToHelp hashtag.
  - PIN will also welcome entries via email at [info@PINnetwork.ca](mailto:info@PINnetwork.ca) for individuals who do not use Instagram. Those entries will be shared by PIN via Instagram for the voting portion
- Artists, photographers and supporters are invited to join in to spread the word and engage on social media through tagging other artists, share with other artists, art and photography organizations and business
- PIN committee will choose finalists followed by a two-week Instagram voting period for community to choose the winner. Voting is February 19 – March 6.
- Winning submission is developed into a small framed print and presented to PIN Volunteer Award winners at the virtual 'Time to Give' event on April 29, 2022

### Winning Artist will receive:

- \$500 honorarium
- Promotion exposure leading into National Volunteer Week event
- Winner featured in PIN's 'Time to Give' programme and digital booklet
- Winner featured on PIN's website, social media, e-communications
- Winning art turned into a small framed print as Volunteer Award for 2022.
